Regular Verbs

Rule: Present Tense + "ed"

cook + "ed" = cooked

play + "ed" = played

Irregular Verbs

Rule: No Rule

Some irregular verbs use a different word for the past tense form. Other irregular verbs use the same word as the present tense for the past tense.

shake = shook

wear = wore

set = set

cut = cut
